Hungary is an EQA member since 2004.

The Hungarian Patchwork Guild was established in 1989, and it operates as a registered NGO. The membership of close to 500 belongs to some 90 active groups across the country. The groups make up eight informal regional organizations that enjoy some degree of autonomy. The regional groups organize exhibitions, contests, workshops and summer retreats, and work towards charitable causes.

In order to preserve the traditions of old-time guilds, new members are expected to make a block of 8 by 8 inches within one year of admission, which are sewn together into large-scale guild charters.
