We made a short survey about the recycling process and the benefits to the environment...



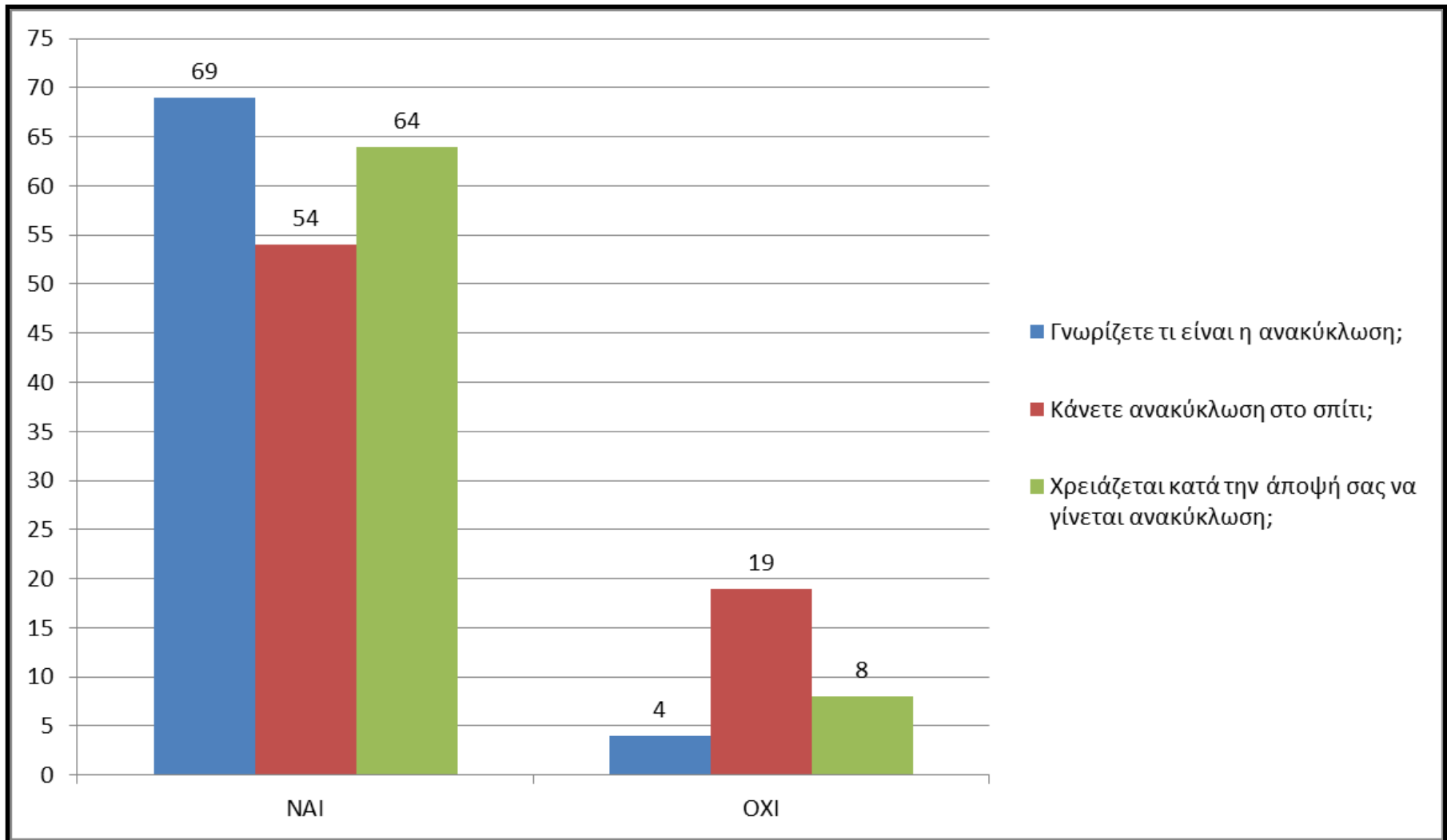
We produced and distributed a leaflet to children and teachers of our school informing them about the importance of recycling

We visited a paper recycling plant...



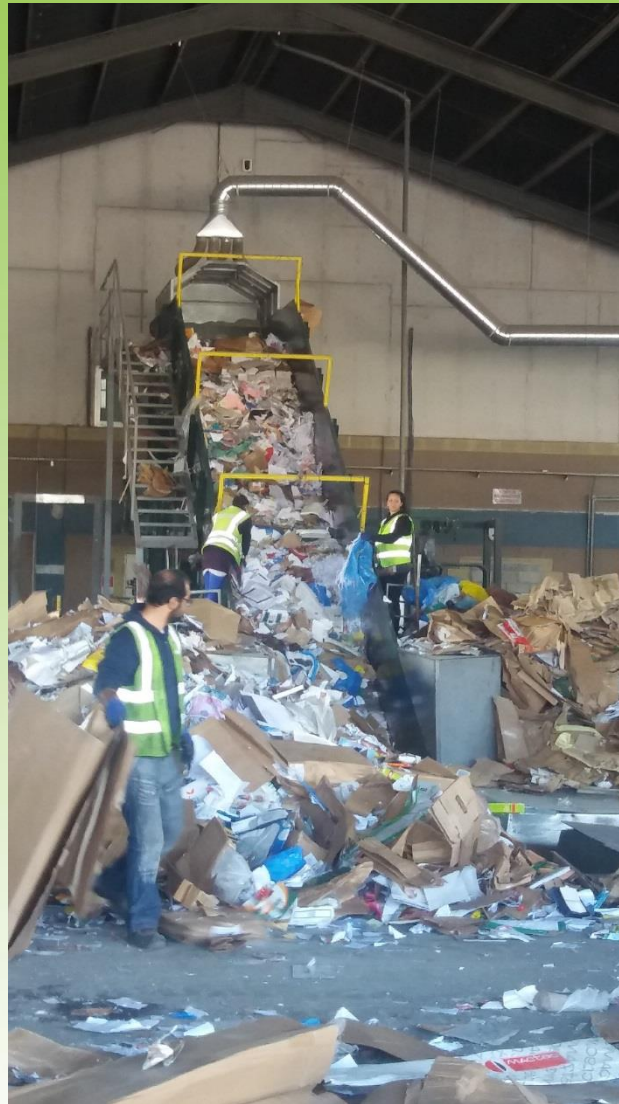
...and a scrap metal recycle plant...
