






Do you like the idea of the international cooperation between schools in your school?




Do you think that your involvement in the project will increase your language skills and competences?




Do you think that your involvement in the project will increase your IT competences?



Do you think that students' exchange is a good way to increase your language skills?





How did you take part in the project activities?




